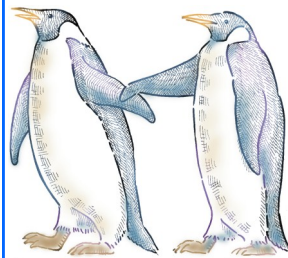




## Pastor's Message

If you feel God has led you to Calvary Hill, you may come forward during the invitation and express your desire to the pastor.

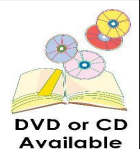
1. By public profession of faith in Jesus Christ, to be followed by Baptism by immersion.
